what is hazardous waste?

The Waste Management Act, 1996, defines waste as something, which the holder discards, intends to discard or is required to discard. Waste is hazardous if it has any properties specified in Part III of the schedule - i.e. flammable, corrosive, toxic, irritant, oxidising, etc. If your waste is hazardous then...

- It must be classified correctly using the European Waste Catalogue Tool (www.epa.ie)
- Packaged in the correct drums, using ADR approved drums if applicable
- Transported on road only by a carrier in possession of a valid Waste Collection Permit
- Accepted and treated/disposed of only by a licensed Waste Management Company
- Have all data compiled for Annual Environmental Report submission, if IPPC licensed
- Have all applicable paperwork compiled and completed, including waste transfer forms, transfrontier shipments, certificates of treatment and/or disposal

Enva can assign R-Codes where applicable to certain wastes depending on the final destination of the waste stream. We have licensed partner sites in Belgium, Germany & France. All of these sites offer state-of-the-art recycling/recovery options, whilst also being commercially advantageous for our customers.
