waste oil

Since 1972, Enva (formerly Atlas Oil) offers a nationwide waste oil collection service throughout Ireland using a fleet of specialist collection vehicles, along with fully trained drivers.

Enva collect and recycle the following Waste Oils:

- Engine oil
- Lubricating oil
- Gearbox oil
- Hydraulic oil
- Diesel, gas oil and kerosene
- Light, medium and heavy fuel oil
- Electrical insulation oil
- Heat transfer oil
- Turbine oil
- Transformer oil
- Skydrol
- Aqueous waste
- Aviation fuel



The range of solutions and services that Enva offer include:

- Free of Charge Waste Oil collections
- Large fleet of collection vehicles
- Scheduled and call-out services offered nationwide
- Waste management packages to suit all customers' requirements
- Wide range of complimentary services, including competitive prices paid for lead acid batteries
- EPA licensed facilities in Portlaoise, Shannon, Cork and Dublin

When collected, the waste oil is transferred to our EPA licensed facility in Portlaoise, where it is reprocessed to meet certain specifications as stipulated in our waste licence (184-1). Under the Waste Management Act (1996), it is illegal to use waste oil burners without an EPA licence or to use unlicensed contractors to dispose of waste oil.



packaged waste

Using a fleet of specialist collection vehicles, along with trained drivers, Enva offers a collection service for hazardous packaged waste including:

- Used oil filters
- Mixed fuels
- Antifreeze / Coolants
- Brake fluid
- Empty plastic drums
- Empty metal drums
- Oil contaminated rags
- Used oil absorbents
- Grease
- Oil spill kits
- Aerosols
- Lead acid batteries
- Liquid and solid paint waste
- Paint containers



When collected, the waste is transferred to one of our EPA licensed facilities where it is reprocessed to meet the necessary standards and regulations, or exported to the appropriate waste management recycling facilities.

All employees are trained to the highest standards. Enva have a number of Dangerous Goods Safety Advisors (D.G.S.A) on hand to give advice on the appropriate containers for the safe storage and transportation of the waste.



tracking of waste

Enva's bespoke tracking system will track all packaged waste from collection until final destination for recovery. Our reporting system will provide full traceability.



certificates of collection & treatment

.....

Enva give customers the comfort of providing a certificate of collection and treatment for the wastes that we collect. We verify that all wastes were collected and treated in an appropriate manner and in accordance with all Irish environmental legislation.

In addition, Enva ensures that all waste is carried under ADR requirement for the carriage of dangerous goods by road, thus ensuring that all waste is transferred from our customers' facilities in the appropriate containers and with the correct documentation, including tremcards, dangerous goods notes and appropriate labelling.



quality control

Enva is ISO 14001 registered, which forms the basis of our quality control procedure.

Enva can also offer a range of associated products to facilitate the safe management of waste oil and associated waste. Some of these products include the following:

waste oil tanks

Enva can offer customers bunded waste oil tanks for the safe storage of waste oil.

- Integrally bunded with 110% overspill capacity
- Guaranteed for 10 years
- Competitively priced
- Easily installed – on groundwork required

These are manufactured from top quality polyethylene for strength and durability, ensuring that they can never rust or rot, and are guaranteed for ten years.

Installation is easy and no groundwork is required. They also meet the site licensing requirements of the EPA; they are integrally bunded with 110% overspill capacity and there are no outlets through the bund. A rotationally moulded construction makes them highly resistant to leakages.



oil spill kits

Enva promotes a range of emergency response spill kits. For fast oil spill response, the most popular kit supplied by Enva is a 240 litre mobile spill kit for use on small-to-medium sized spills.
